Cemetery: One foundation poured for headstone, two cremation burials. Bills for the month – 61.00 Alpha building center, 57.54 shell gas, 59.62 shell diesel.

Ordinance: M. Haydon discussed the cost of clean up of properties within the township.

Treasurer: General fund 164,621.58 and the tax payment fund at 158,594.26

Clerk: Getting ready of the August 4 State Primary. 563 ballots were given out (about 43 percent of registered voters in the township. All inspectors trained for August, public test of equipment set for the 23<sup>rd</sup>, completed a number of reports

Supervisor: Prep work for board of review and tax tribunal, dust control application, reviewing zoning for land division and combinations.

Bills and budget review:

Lutz moved to accept the monthly bills of 47,126.38 with an EFT of 4,796.29. Seconded by Peterson seconded. Motion passed.

Peterson moved to hire Rusk excavating to clean up property in the township. Davis seconded. Motion passed with Rigby abstaining.
