**Lake Templene Improvement Board Meeting**  
**Nottawa Township Hall**

- **Call to Order** – Meeting called to Order by Dave Peterson, Nottawa Twp. Supervisor, at 1:30pm.
- **Pledge of Allegiance**
- **Roll Call of Attendees** – David Peterson, Steve Wolf, Patricia Boomer (via phone), Jeffery Wenzel and Christina Yunker.  
Max McKelvey, Shirley Betts, and PLM representatives; Jason, Andy, and Ashley.
- **Rules of Meeting** – Please turn off cell phones or take calls outside of the meeting room. Comments are limited to 3 minutes.
- **Approval of today’s meeting agenda and the minutes from prior LTIB meeting** – The minutes from January 15, 2026, meeting and the agenda items for tonight’s meeting were approved on a motion from Steve Wolf, supported by Jeff Wenzel, motion carried.
- **Treasurer’s Report** – No updates currently.
- **Payment of Bills** – No bills to pay currently.
- **PLM discussion & concerns:**
  - a. Dave Peterson spoke regarding the issue with the 2025 summer lake treatment that PLM performed. He mentioned that the Lake Templene Board had some concerns.
  - b. Shirley Betts mentioned that it was a difficult year for our lake with weed issues. There were many complaints throughout the summer from other residents on the lake about the weed control and lack of communication.
    - Jason with PLM asked the board what they can do differently. He agreed that Progressive AE was a good company to work with but mentioned that Progressive could have communicated better with concerns and inadequate surveys with better treatment maps. Jason made the comment that PLM can do the treatment maps themselves and apply the chemicals so that they know exactly what is going on with having their own consultants.
    - Andy with PLM mentioned that in the future he would be in the boat with Progressive AE as they do their treatment maps, that way PLM would know how much extra chemicals they would need to treat the lake.
    - Shirley Betts made the comment that Lake Templene rarely has blue/green algae, but Lake Templene did have a lot of algae over the course of 2025. In reference

to the bacteria & bio augmentation treatments for the lake, Ashley mentioned that it adds phosphorus to the lake contributing to the blue/green algae.

- c. Patricia Boomer made a comment about receiving the service and communication Lake Templene had when they hired Clarke Aquatics to treat the lake.
  - Jason with PLM explained how the spray boats work to treat the lake but ultimately it is the decision of the Lake Templene Improvement Board on how they want to move forward.
- d. Dave Peterson addressed the board about needing to decide on how to move forward for the treatments of Lake Templene in 2026.

Before PLM representatives were dismissed from the meeting, the Board asked them to give a quote for the lake management/surveys in addition to the weed control and estimated costs for recommendations for future plans & studies.

- **After PLM was dismissed-**
  - a. Dave Peterson moved and Steve Wolf supported that we discontinue services provided by Progressive AE company. Motion carried unanimously.
  - b. Steve Wolf made the motion to look into moving our financials and getting an account with Southern Michigan Bank, Dave Peterson supported. Motion carried unanimously.
