Ordinance number 47: Impose a limited moratorium on the development of dog kennels and dog breeding facilities so as to permit the Township planning commission and board to develop regulations regarding the same in line with current state law. Lutz moved to approve ordinance 47, Rigby seconded. Roll Call vote: 5-0 approved.
