Visitors: Sturgis Toy Run representatives asked for ordinances/applications that need to be filled for a one-day bike run and cook out held within the township. Date: September 8th.

Monthly reports:

Fire: Chief Loker gave report and discussion on replacement of fire trucks.

Library: Phase one of construction almost completed. Monthly report on file.

Assessor: Report on file.

Cemetery: Poured 2 foundations, 5 burials spaces sold, 3 deeds, 6 burials this month. Sun Dial holding 2 cremations' stolen from Prairie River cemetery. Police report filed. New flags and grave markers are here. Centreville 8th grade and high school students will place flags on Veteran's graves this week. Bills include 80.44 gas, 112.02 diesel, 131.74 Nottawa lumber, 137.64 Greenmark.

Treasurer's report: General Fund 251,781.96 without special assessments.

Clerk's and Supervisor's report on file.

Bills and budget: Lutz moved to approve bills in the amount of 59,180.10 with and EFT transfer of 4,563.81 - Rigby seconded, motion passed.

Election results: 138 voters for the May special election.

Committee/Board Reports:

Planning: Clark gave a report on the special use permit that was approved by Commission.

Fire: Davis discussed the needs of the fire department and encouraged increases for the upcoming budgets.

Zoning Board of Appeals: Discussed the Hart variance to the zoning ordinance.

Old Business:
