Summer Taxes

The summer tax bill is included in this mailing. Taxes may be paid to Nottawa Township as soon as you receive the tax bill until September 15, 2025. Taxes may be paid in person or drop box at the township hall, 112 S. Clark St, Centreville, by mail to PO 68, Centreville, MI 49032, or by credit card. August 5: Fire and Emergency Services Millage Renewal

In 2019 the voters of Nottawa Township approved a .75 mil tax for Fire and Emergency Services for six years. This millage has helped make it possible for the Centreville Fire Department to purchase a new fire truck last year and to fund our subsidy share for Life Care Ambulance service and also help with the village of Centreville's subsidy share.

On August 5, 2025 the .75 mil tax is on the ballot for renewal for six years.

Roads

Roads in Nottawa Township have seen improvement over the last few years. This year the township has shared in the cost of new asphalt on Truckenmiller Rd from Bucknell to Nottawa Rd. The schedule for next year includes nearly three miles of new asphalt on Findley Rd.

This summer the township has partnered with the County Road Commission for two applications of dust control on all 20 miles of gravel roads in Nottawa Township.

Nottawa Township is home to two county parks: Sand Lake Park is located **at** 60778 Railroad Street Nottawa, MI 49075 and Covered Bridge Farm is located at 56705 Covered Bridge Road Three Rivers, MI 49093
